
DESK SHELF PLANS

FENCE PICKET VERSION

- Materials: one fence picket (approx. 5/8 in. x 5-1/2 in. x 6 ft.)
- Cut six pieces of 6.5 in. each;
- Cut four pieces of 5.5 in each;
- For each product you will need three 6.5 in, and two 5.5 in. pieces and one fence picket should yield two completed products;
- Assemble using butt joints with recessed screws;
- Before painting, cover the screws and joints with shrink free spackling paste (I used Sherwin Williams brand)
- After sanding with 120, 220 and 320 or 400 grit sandpaper, paint using spray paint
- Finish with spray lacquer



HARDWOOD VERSION

- Materials: One board of hardwood (I used white oak but walnut or maple would also look great) (approx. 1in. X 6 in. X 40 in.)
- The pieces are all total length of 7 in. and the cuts are all 45 degrees
- Two pieces only have one angle cut while three pieces have two angle cuts as shown below and in the video
- Assemble using glue and clamp with tape and clamps as needed
- After sanding with 120, 220 and 320 or 400 grit, finish with spray lacquer
